This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you... (1 John 1:5).

... transgression of the law (1 John 3:4; Here, he is talking about the perfect law of liberty spoken of by James; James 1:25).

What are some of these transgressions of God's law? The lack of control over the tongue (James 1:26). A person who allows their pride to rule their lives (James 1:23-24; 2:1-4). In Proverbs 6:16 the wise man Solomon wrote:

These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him: A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, a false witness that speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren (Here are the symptoms of sin).

The apostle John identifies three avenues of sin. "Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world" (1 John 2:15–16).

How often do we see these symptoms in those of the world? How often do we see them in the lives of our brothers and sisters? Many Christians live on the edge of falling away because they want to live sort of like the world but not to the degree of indulgence of the worldly. The cure for sin is obedience to the will of God. John said, "But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin" (1 John 1:7). How close to sinful activities can one get before becoming tainted by sin? Can a bride in her white gown crawl through a coal

bin without her gown being ruined by the coal dust? Some think they can watch "R" rated movies without being affected by them. Others think nothing of repeating gossip while some think that just a sip of alcohol is not going to affect them. We need to instill in the hearts of everyone the need to stay as close as we can to God and as far as we can from the world. God wants you as His servant. "Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee" (Psalm 119:11).

# BE NOT WEARY IN WELL DOING
