Do we measure how blessed we are based upon where we are in our social standing in the world? Do we measure how blessed we are by counting the costs of our homes, cars, clothing, or quality of food? Truly, God has given us an abundance of physical blessings and for them we should thank him, but if we measure how blessed we are by physical attainment, the non-Christian world around us may appear to be more blessed than we. - 4. "Blessed is he that considereth the poor: the LORD will deliver him in time of trouble" (Psalm 41:1).

## MOVING THE LINES

On the front page of last week's issue of *The Democrat* [the local newspaper], there was an article informing us of the Tate County School District lines being moved. If I understand correctly, they have been moved in preparation of establishing a new school board. No opinion on that action is here provided, but it did remind me of a most important Bible principle. God's Word provides the boundary lines for right living, and these lines cannot be moved by man.

After rising from the grave and before ascending into heaven, Jesus said, "All authority has been given to me in heaven and on earth" (Matthew 28:18). Jesus' having all authority means that he draws the lines. Just like you can go to the courthouse to find out what the county district lines are, you can go to the Word of God to find out what Jesus' lines are for right living. "He who rejects me, and does not receive my words, has that which judges him—the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day" (John 12:48). Jesus went on to say also, "If you love me, you will keep my commandments" (John 14:15). However, many people do not love Jesus. They cross his lines and some even try to move them with their false teachings.

The sobering fact is that all will be judged by his authoritative word in the last day. But the motivating truth is that you do not have to be found outside of Jesus' boundary lines on that day. If you are reading this article, you have a blessed opportunity. You have an opportunity to believe who Jesus is and what he has done for you (see Mark 16:16). Your belief will motivate you to repent as God requires (see Acts 2:38). To repent literally means to change your mind. Whereas you once did not care about Jesus' boundary lines, crossed them, and maybe even tried to move them to your own liking, you will now have your mind set on constantly striving to stay within Jesus' lines. Per Jesus' commandments, your faith and repentance will be followed by confessing your faith in Jesus (see Romans 10:10) and submitting yourself to immersion in water (see 1 Peter 3:21).

Again, no opinion or judgment is here being made concerning the moving of the school district lines. But when it comes to living right, there are some Biblical lines that cannot be moved. Are you in God's district?
