

established on the day of Pentecost in Jerusalem (Acts 2). Christians are to do good unto all men (Galatians 6:10) and so can serve others through helping friends and neighbors and even serving in organizations that are not the church. However, the primary area of service for Christians is in and through the body of Christ.

The area of service for Christians is in the body of Christ and according to their abilities and talents (1 Corinthians 12:13-20). Every Christian has an ability and talent whereby one can serve in the church and be of service the Lord. The question becomes; Am I willing to serve? Jesus said "The greatest among you will be your servant" (Mathew 23:11) and Peter wrote that each Christian should serve according to their ability (1 Peter 4:10). The question becomes; Am I willing to serve? Service was not easy for Jesus as he left heaven and came to the earth (Philippians 2:6-7), and service was not each for any of the Apostles or brethren, but they served. Service for them meant leaving the comforts that they knew in order to serve.

Leaving comforts that we knows does not mean that one must travel hundreds or thousands of miles away to be a servant, but it does mean that we will do something different, we will serve. Maybe you have never been a greeter and welcome brethren and guests to the church building, but there can be a first time to serve. Maybe you as a male member of the congregation have never said a prayer publicly, but there is always a first time. Maybe you have not prepared communion for the Sunday worship, but there can be a first time to serve in that way. Maybe you have never been the last person to leave the church building, the one to check that all doors are locked, lights turned off, and no one left behind, but there can be a first time to serve in that way. Serving the Lord and others means having a heart to help others and do something that needs to be done even if you have never done it. Seize the opportunity to serve in the body of Christ.
