Paul hated the fact that some of the Christians in Corinth are still in the infant stage. "I gave you milk, not solid food, for you were not ready for it. Indeed, you still are not ready. You are still worldly" (1 Cor. 3:2-3). He goes on to say that some have a bad case of "preacheritis", idolizing either Paul, Apollos, or Cephas. Their focus is distracted from Christ and true spirituality. The baby stage is cute, but it would be a tragedy for a baby to never grow up. What percent would desire to spoon feed a child or change its diaper for the rest of its life? Maturity should be the goal of every Christian and every church leader. See Ephesians 4:14. The growth of a baby takes great effort on both the part of the parents and the child himself. One of the obstacles of an infant learning to walk is the pain of falling down. He must overcome the fear of falling. When he does fall, he must get up and try again. Every Christian must overcome the fear of falling and criticism to grow in service to Christ. The writer of Hebrews was disheartened that many of his readers were still at the infant stage. At that particular time in their lives, they should've been teaching others about Christ. Instead they were in need of a refresher course (Heb. 5:12-14). Necessary growth requires constant study, service and perseverance. Get back up and try again.
